



Halloween Eye Balls

Create these easy and delicious eyeballs for Halloween.

Recipe:

Plain Donut Holes
Simi Sweet White Chocolate
Green and Red Fondant
Red Piping Gel
Flour

Suggested Equipment:

Double Boiler
Cookie tray with parchment paper
Toothpicks
Skewers
Piping Bakers Tip #4 or #6
Rolling Pin

In your double boiler add the semi-sweet white chocolate chips. While the chips are melting place parchment paper on the cookie tray and position it between the donut holes and double boiler, creating an assembly line. Once the white chocolate is melted to the right consistency (running off your spatula) take a donut hole, stick it to the end of a skewer and roll donut hole in melted white chocolate until it's covered in chocolate. Allow as much chocolate to drip off the donut hole as possible. Use the tooth pick to slide the donut hole off the skewer and onto the parchment paper to cool. Repeat this process until all the donut holes are covered.



Once the donuts are cooled, lightly dust your countertop with flour along with your rolling pin. Don't overdo the flour it's just there to prevent the fondant sticking. No one wants to taste raw flour.

Note: Fondant will dry out quickly so time is of the essence.

Take your fondant, one color at time. Slightly work it with your hands to make it pliable. Two or three slight tugs should do it. Place the fondant on your floured counter and roll it out to a evenly thin sheet. Take your piping tip and use the large opening to cut perfect little green fondant circles. Flip your tip over to the smaller end and punch out black fondant circles. Take a small bowl or a damp clean cloth and wet with water. To give the fondant a shiny look handle the fondant circles with damp fingers. This will also remove any flour left on the fondant. Place the green fondant circles on the hole created by the skewer on the donut hole. On top of the green fondant place a black fondant circle.

Once the all the donuts have fondant pupils, take your red piping Gel. Use the smallest piping tip available and draw crooked red lines from the bottom of the donut hole to the top. Connecting a few for a realistic look.
